Slap-on: “THE LEAF AND DEBRIS COLLECTING ATTACHMENT”

The Slap-on attachment has been engineered to slide over the side of a large, commercial grade, square container to secure a can liner in place. This enables leaves or debris to be raked or swept directly into the bag while the receptacle is set on its side. The purpose of the Slap-on attachment is to prevent the liner from collapsing to the base of the receptacle, speeding the bagging of debris.

Prongs slide easily over the plastic liner and reach the receptacle’s base. Off-setting outside prongs hold inner prongs close to the receptacle’s side, securing the can liner to the base of the receptacle.

The Slap-on Attachment may be used with the following waste receptacles sold through W.W. Grainger:

- W.W. Grainger’s Tough Guy 48 and 55 gallon square receptacles
 - Rubbermaid’s Brute 40 gallon square receptacle

- Place a can liner inside of a square receptacle. (Ensure that the can liner is the right size for the container and that the liner fits loosely around the lip of the container.)
 - The Slap-on attachment has four prongs, two longer prongs and two offsetting, shorter prongs. Slide the Slap-on attachment over a side of the receptacle that does not have a handle so that the longer prongs are inside of the receptacle and the shorter prongs are outside of the receptacle. The latch on the attachment should slide over the lip of the receptacle.
 - Lay the receptacle on the side opposite of the side that is secured by the Slap-on attachment.
 - Rake or sweep debris into receptacle.
 - Pull receptacle upright when it is relatively full of debris, using a rake or other tool to close off opening of the container when lifting.
 - Push debris down in container if necessary to compact.. (Use free hand to hold can liner in place on the side opposite of the Slap-on attachment.)
 - Pull full can liner from receptacle and tie the bag closed.
 - Repeat the process
